3. At the outset, the committee noted the facts that selection of candidates is to be made for filling up the vacancies earmarked for appointment on compassionate grounds for the Recruitment Years 2017-18, 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2021 as per details given below:-


4. The various issues relating to compassionate appointments were discussed as per the guidelines of CBDT laid down vide letter. No. A-12012/03/2021-Ad. VII dated 15.04.2021 and the relevant guidelines issued by DoPT from time to time on the subject, wherein criteria and methodology have been duly laid out. It was felt by the Committee that in order to have necessary details in respect of all the applicants (as approved by the Competent Authority), a proforma may be devised wherein the relevant personal details of the candidates as well as information in relation to the deceased employee need to be duly filled in by the applicants. It was also decided that it may be specifically mentioned in the communication to be issued to the applicants

that if any column/row in the said proforma is/are left by the candidates, the Committee/Authority reserves the right to treat such applications as incomplete and/or invalid. A draft proforma, which needs to be sent to all the applicants, was placed before the Committee and duly approved by the Committee. It was decided that the proforma shall be circulated/sent to all the applicants in order to collect the required up-to-date data in respect of the required parameters laid down by the Board.

5. During the meeting it was decided that the candidates should submit the required details in the newly prescribed proforma within 15 days of receipt of the letters. These details are required to be submitted by the applicants in any one of the mode, i.e. either physical submission in the office of the Pr. Chief Commissioner of Income Tax, West Bengal & Sikkim or by post or by email. It was also decided that the next meeting of the committee will be called after compilation of the necessary data received from all the applicants. The meeting was concluded with the permission of the chair.

- 3. The following points were discussed in the meeting keeping in view different circulars/guidelines issued by DOP&T and CBDT from time to time on the matter of compassionate appointment-
- i) It was decided by the Committee that in the case of candidates where the letters issued earlier by this office were returned unserved, a final opportunity may be given by way of a reminder by serving the letters by hand. It was also decided that in the case of the candidates who have not submitted the duly filled-in proforma till date, reminder may be issued by post and in all the above cases, the candidates would be requested to submit the duly filled-in proforma within 07 days of receipt of the letter.
- ii) The eligibility of the candidates regarding attaining the age of 18 (eighteen) years was decided to be counted as on the 31st December of the Year of Death of the Deceased.
- iii) The cut-off date for considering different issues in relation to catering points like age, educational qualifications, years of service to be rendered by the widow candidates, etc. is to be taken as on 31-12-2021.
- iv) In case of terminal benefits submitted as nil by certain candidates, an approximate amount is to be obtained from the concerned DDO. Further, in case of some old/roll over candidates, if it is found that the quantum of terminal benefit submitted earlier differs from the same submitted in the present submission, the amount of terminal benefits whichever is higher is to be considered.
- v) Value of segregation is to be ascertained/adapted for the different kind of immovable property shown by the candidates i.e. House property as detailed below:

vi) While catering points on Liabilities, candidates to be awarded 5 points where there is a differently able son/daughter of the deceased employee and 3 points to be awarded where there is a loan exists and process of disbursing is continuing till date.

Candidates who are still submitting initial applications where date of death occurred in 2021 or before, they shall be included for the present process for appointment on compassionate ground.

viii) Separate merit lists are to be prepared for the Recruitment Years 2017-18, 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2021, depending upon the points awarded to the applicants on the basis of the particulars in respect of various parameters prescribed in the CBDT guidelines as per the CBDT letter F.No: A-12012/03/2021-Ad.VII dated 15-04-2021. It was decided that in the case of the candidates who get equal marks, preference is to be given having regard to / on the basis of the length of left over service of the deceased, taking into account the fact that the family suffered more where length of service left was longer.

ix) If it is found subsequent to preparation of the merit list that a candidate did not fulfill the requisite eligibility criteria or furnished wrong information in the submitted proforma, then the candidature of such candidate would be cancelled without any reference to the candidate. Further, if a candidate, after being selected through merit list, refuses the offer of appointment, then the subsequent candidate on the merit list may be considered for appointment.







- 1. The following points were discussed in the meeting keeping in view different circulars/guidelines issued by DOP&T and CBDT from time to time on the matter of compassionate appointment-
- It is found from the submission of the candidates that, most of them have submitted in the column "movable and immovable property (latest value) including fixed deposit etc. except terminal benefits" details as NIL and in the subsequent column "Annual Income of earning members and income from movable/immovable property" details as NIL. It was brought to the notice of the committee that the full points earmarked for each of the above criteria is 10. Since it is found that it is highly difficult to ascertain the veracity of the claim made by the applicants in these two columns, to avoid any ambiguity it was decided by the committee to obtain declarations in the form of duly notarized affidavit from the applicants in this respect.
- ii) The required affidavit format may be sent to the candidates as Annexure to forwarding letter and they may be asked to submit the same within 10 days of receipt of the letter.

iii) It was also decided by the committee that in case any applicant who is shortlisted for the appointment is found to be either a case of belated request or below the prescribed qualification, the same would be submitted to the Admin for necessary action as per extant



- 1. The following points were discussed in the meeting keeping in view of different circulars/guidelines issued by DOP&T and CBDT from time to time on the matter of compassionate appointment
 - i) In the case of deceased employee submitted by both of her daughter and son Though the daughter of the deceased has submitted her unwillingness but son of the deceased employee could not submit his proforma till date after issuing reminder. Hence, it is decided by the Committee that the case may be dropped from the ongoing recruitment process and may be considered in the next Recruitment Year i.e. 2022.
 - the deceased employee nominating her son. As the greater portion of work related to the present process for appointment on compassionate ground is over and the new inclusion may delay the process, hence, it is decided by the Committee that the case may be considered in the next Recruitment Year i.e. 2022.
 - iii) The Selection Committee has decided to keep the candidates above 58 years out of Selection Zone.
 - iv) It is decided by the Committee that there are five cases as detailed below where it is found that the candidate was not dependent upon the deceased employee at the time of death of the deceased employee. Hence, the Selection Committee has decided to keep the candidate out of consideration.

- 2. Further it is viewed by the Committee that until the result for Data Entry Skill Test in respect of the Graduate candidates against the vacancy of 10 Tax Assistants is obtained, no merit list can be prepared. Hence, to expedite the process it is decided by the Committee that the Data Entry Skill Test may be conducted by the competent authority i.e. the Examination & Training Section on 23.09.2022 and all the candidates may be informed through the means of postal and electronic communication immediately. For Data Entry Skill Test out of 108 number of Graduate candidates it is decided by the Committee that as per merit points maximum number of candidates may be called for the said test in a 1:7 ratio. The list of graduate candidates is scrutinized and decided to call 73 candidates with the minimum marks scored 25 for Data Entry Skill Test. The committee entrusts the O/o the DCIT, Hqrs, (Pers. & Estt.), Kolkata to co-ordinate with Examination & Training Section for the Data Entry Skill Test.
- 3. It was also decided by the Committee that in case any applicant who is shortlisted for the appointment, is found to be either a case of belated request or below the prescribed qualification, the same would be submitted for necessary approval of the Revenue Secretary through proper channel as per extant guidelines in this regard. Further, the Committee also opined that in case the belated or below qualified cases proposed by the Committee are disapproved by the Revenue Secretary, then next choice would be the candidate in the reserve list who is not belated or below qualified and whose case do not required approval by the Revenue Secretary.

Resolution No 1: As decided by the committee in earlier meeting dated 13.09.2022 a Data Entry Skill Test for graduate candidates conducted on 23.09.2022. 




In view of the above, the Committee observed that since didn't declare the above income, which is wrong submission and keeping in mind the observations and facts in this case which is elaborately detailed in minutes dated 13.10.2022. 




