CIRCULAR

Subject - Constitution of a Medical Facilitation Cell for Serving & Retired Officers/Officials - Staff Welfare Initiative - reg.

As part of a welfare measure for our serving & retired Officers and Officials of the Income Tax Department in West Bengal & Sikkim region and in order to provide timely medical assistance to them, the Principal Chief Commissioner of Income Tax, West Bengal & Sikkim, is pleased to announce the establishment of medical cells to provide dedicated medical coordination and support.

2. Objective:

The Medical Cells are being constituted with the following objectives:

- a) To establish a systematic and streamlined process for facilitating priority medical treatment/consultation for serving & retired Officers and Officials.
- b) To ensure timely access to efficient healthcare services.
- c) To enable quick coordination and response during medical emergencies.

3. **Scope:**

This welfare measure shall apply to:

➤ All serving & retired Officers and Officials of the Department residing in the state of West Bengal, Sikkim & the Union Territory of Andaman & Nicobar Islands who require medical support for themselves or their immediate family members.



4. The authorized officer and the medical cells along with their respective jurisdiction is hereby constituted for the West Bengal & Sikkim Region as under:

5. Coordination Framework:

e)

The following steps will be undertaken for smooth facilitation:

- a) A dedicated Officer will be identified to serve as the Single Point of Contact (SPOC) for all medical support requests in each jurisdiction as mentioned in Para No. 4 above.
- b) The SPOC will help in resolving procedural difficulties & facilitate priority medical treatment/consultation.
- c) Contact details of the SPOC team will be provided for direct access by serving & retired Officials/Officers.
- d) The authorised officer may co-opt members from other charges at the respective stations/districts under their charge.
 - In view of the large geographical expanse of the jurisdiction and other administrative reasons, the authorized officer may modify the above coordination framework to facilitate more efficient working of the medical cells vis-à-vis station wise formation of Medical Cells etc.

6. Responsibilities:

Role of Serving/Retired Officers and Officials:

Serving/Retired officers and officials are requested to send a message specifying the following details:

- a) Nature of the medical requirement.
- b) Preferred hospital/medical institution/date of appointment.
- c) Department/specialty for which the reference is required.
- d) Medical diagnosis or treatment needed (if available).
- e) Complete contact information (address, phone number, email).

Role of Liaison Officer/Helpdesk/SPOC:

For CGHS-related issues:

> Coordinate with the concerned SPOC for appropriate resolution.

For private hospital-related issues:

➤ Coordinate with the PRO of the concerned hospital. If unresolved, escalate the matter to the next higher authority for prompt action.

In case of emergencies:

Serving/Retired Officers and Officials should proceed directly with hospital admission and treatment as per their CGHS/Departmental entitlement without waiting for team response. The team will, however, make every effort to provide early assistance.

7. Nature of the Measure:

This initiative is an informal welfare measure to ensure access to timely and effective healthcare. It is not a statutory right and does not supersede CGHS rules or other departmental policies. The Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for this initiative will be reviewed annually or as required.

8. <u>Implementation:</u>

This welfare initiative will be implemented as per the objectives stated above.
